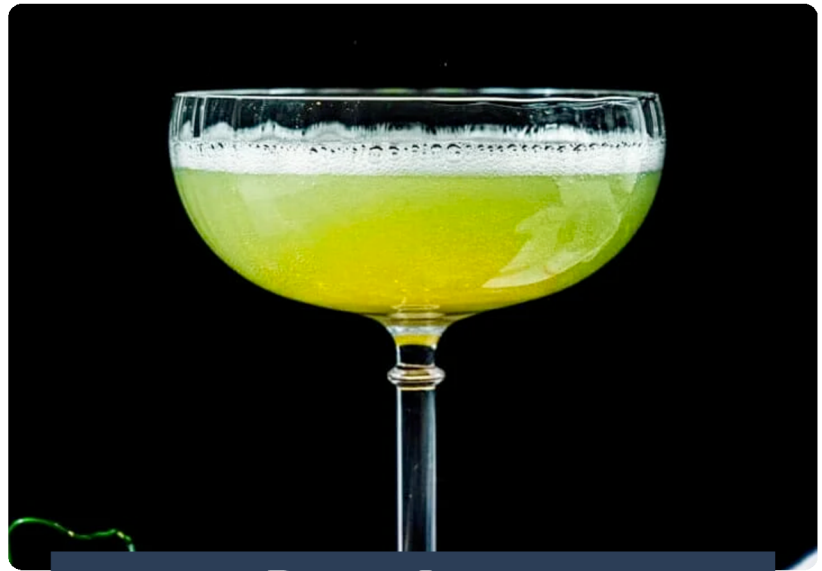

- 40 ML ABSINTHE
- CHAMPAGNE OR PROSECCO

METHOD

POUR ABSINTHE (40 ML) INTO A CHAMPAGNE GLASS. ADD ICE-COLD CHAMPAGNE UNTIL IT REACHES THE DESIRED OPALESCENT MILKINESS.
